The Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ) is seeking **Request for Proposals (RFP)** from international or local Jordanian firms for pilot testing, financing, design, construction, operation and transfer of Khan Al-Zabib Wells Water Treatment and Supply Project under a Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) basis.

The Project aims to develop a treatment solution for high-radioactivity groundwater extracted from Khan Al-Zabib wellfield, with the objective of supplying treated potable water to the central Governorates.

The selected Applicants will be required to conduct a pilot test at their own cost and risk prior to full scale implementation. Following successful completion of the Pilot Stage and the Employer's approval, the selected Contractor shall be fully responsible for arranging and securing all financing required for the BOT implementation stage of the Project.

During the operational phase, the purchaser of the treated water shall pay for the water quantities supplied in accordance with the relevant Water Purchase Agreement (WPA) to be executed at a later stage. Payments shall be based on the tariff proposed by the Contractor in its Financial Proposal and accepted by the Employer, and on the actual quantities of water purchased and delivered.

Local Jordanian contractors shall be classified as Grade (1) in Water and Wastewater, Grade (1) in Environment as per the GTD classification, Grade (1) Operation and Maintenance Works, Grade (1) Drilling and Well Works and also Grade (1) Electromechanical Works. International contractors shall demonstrate at least equivalent qualifications. Contractors which demonstrate adequate experience may qualify for the above-mentioned works. To qualify, contractors must demonstrate adequate design capacity, either in-house or through a nominated subcontractor.

A complete set of bidding documents is available to interested Bidders. Documents in English may be purchased and collected upon payment of a non-refundable fee of JOD 500 (Five hundred Jordanian Dinars). The method of payment shall be cash. The last date for purchasing the procurement documents Shall be no later than Wednesday, 3 June 2026

Questions and requests for clarifications shall be sent **21 days prior the submission deadline** and shall be sent by email to the address above.

The bids shall be labelled on the outside with the name of the bidder and as follows: Bid for “Request for Proposal submission for: **Khan Al-Zabib Wells Water Treatment and Supply Project.**” and must be delivered to the address above on or before **12:00pm local time Wednesday, 1 July 2026, the opening session will take a place on the same date 13:00 PM.** Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late submissions will be rejected.

The Project is not exempted from taxes and customs duties.

Bids shall be submitted as one sealed package consisting of the following sealed envelopes:

- Envelope 1: the Bid Security;
- Envelope 2: Technical Proposal (including USB flash of the Technical Proposal)
- Envelope 3: Financial Proposal (including USB flash of the Financial Proposal).

The envelopes must be sealed and placed inside the main package. Each envelope within the package should be clearly labelled with the following information: the number and name of the envelope, the name and number of the tender assignment, and the name of the bidder.

The Technical Proposal must be marked as follows: "Not to be opened with Financial Proposal." The Financial Proposal must be marked as: "Confidential, not to be opened before the Technical Proposal.

In the first public session, only the Bid Security envelope and the Technical Proposal will be opened. In the second public session only the Financial Proposal of those Bidders who have fulfilled the criteria for the Technical Proposal will be opened.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the required format of 500,000 JOD (in words: five hundred thousand Jordanian Dinars) valid for 1st days.

The awarded Bidder shall bear the costs of the advertisement in the gazette for one time.
