The Ministry of Water and Irrigation received Co-financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), hereinafter called the "Bank" and Global Concessional Financing Facility (GCFF) and the Agence Francaise de Developpement (AFD) in the form of a loan hereinafter called "loan" toward the cost of JORDAN WATER SECTOR EFFICIENCY PROGRAM (JWSEP) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for consulting services to be procured under JWSEP.

The consulting services include providing comprehensive technical assistance and support to the Jordan Valley Authority (JVA) throughout the implementation of JWSEP. The assignment of the Technical Expert is to support JVA and provide technical advice and support to the Dam Studies Department in implementing the activities under the JWSEP.

The Jordan Valley Authority now invites eligible consulting individuals ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Consultant CVs and experiences shall also be included in the EOI. The shortlisting criteria are:

- 1. Description of similar assignments, and in similar conditions
- 2. General experience years in business and overall competence in relevance to this assignment.

It is preferable to limit the EoI to a maximum of 10 pages.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.



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Shortlisted Consultants will be invited for interview, upon which a Consultant will be selected for negotiation in accordance with the Individual Consultant Selection described in the "World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers", dated November 2020" and to be specifically set out in the Request for Proposals.
