The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (hereinafter called "Recipient") has received financing from the German Government through KfW Development Bank ("KfW") towards the cost of **Upgrade & Rehabilitation (DBO) for South Amman WWTP at South Amman** and intends to apply the proceeds toward payments under the contract.

The Water Authority of Jordan, acting as implementing agency of the Recipient and referred to as the "Employer", now invites sealed Applications for the Upgrade & Rehabilitation (DBO) for South Amman WWTP.

Background

South Amman WWTP is in the Southern part of Greater Amman at an elevation of 690 masl. It was operated in 2015 to serve the densely populated southern part of Amman. It is the 2nd largest WWTP in Jordan.

The existing South Amman WWTP provides treatment through extended aeration process. This shall be converted to Conventional Activated Sludge Process. The work covered under the investment contract involves both the refurbishment of existing facilities as well as the construction of new facilities to upgrade the level of treatment with sludge digestion and biogas generation. The works might have to envisage to enable the achievements of the irrigation for field crops and discharge to water bodies categories of the Jordanian Effluent Standard. The average capacity of the plant for phase-1 will be 62,000 m³/day.

The existing WWTP is operating using an extended aeration treatment process. The biological stage consists of six rectangular aeration tanks, and five secondary clarifiers. The biological reactors were separated by internal walls into three zones (a) anaerobic zone for phosphorous removal, (b) pre-anoxic zone for denitrification c) aeration zone for oxidation of biodegradable organic matter and ammonia nitrification. The outflow from all sedimentation tanks is conveyed to the tertiary treatment facilities composed of micro disk filters (MDF) and chlorination station for disinfection. Treated effluent can be either discharged to a storage pond or reused locally for irrigation purposes.

The excess sludge from all settling tanks is pumped to the sludge thickeners and sludge holding tanks, then supposed to be transferred to the dewatering facilities. Sludge drying units comprising several drying beds, are provided for stage I only for emergency use. Currently the dewatering facilities are bypassed, and sludge is directly transferred to sludge drying beds.

The construction of the additional trunk lines is not part of the contract except the diversion works required for the influent wastewater pumping station.

The effluent quality shall comply with the irrigation for field crops and discharge to water bodies quality given in Jordanian Standard (JS893/2021).

An Existing Conditions Assessment Report has been prepared. The report covered the assessment of the original design, the historical influent and effluent water quality, operation, and the assessment of the existing situation for all electromechanical equipment and treatment structures. The report has identified the deficiencies in the existing units and the abnormal mode of operation of the plant. The report has directed the attention towards the problem of the intermittent discharge of industrial wastewater mainly from marble and stone cutting factories and olive processing mills, and its detrimental effect on the treatment units

and influent and effluent wastewater quality. The report has recommended short-term measures for improving the current situation and suggested initial alternatives for plant expansion.

Operations of South Amman WWTP for Phase One Expansion

Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ) oversees water and sanitation service provision directly or through public companies that it owns. Miyahuna is a water and sanitation services company owned by WAJ and manages and operates water and sanitation services in the capital Amman and other areas in the middle region of Jordan. The current operator for South Amman WWTP is Miyahuna.

The Contractor shall operate and maintain the WWTP for a period of 15 years after the successful commissioning date under FIDIC Gold Book conditions. After that period, operation, and maintenance shall be transferred to WAJ.

Bidding will be conducted by means of the International Competitive Bidding procedure with qualification as specified in the KfW's Procurement Guidelines ("Guidelines").

Eligible Applicants

Sole Applicants:

Local Jordanian Contractors shall be classified as First Grade in Wastewater Treatment Plants works, First Grade Electromechanical/Renewable Energy, and First Grade in Building Construction as per GTD Classification. Applicant must demonstrate experience in design, build, and operate of WWTPs as indicated in 4.2 (b) and 6.3 (b) Experience in Key Activities.

International Contractors shall at least demonstrate equivalent qualifications by experience for the scope described above.

Or consortium (Joint Venture) of an international and/or Local Contractor with experience in equivalent WWTP projects. Local Jordanian Contractors JV shall be classified as Grade (1) in Construction/Building works, first grade in WWTP, and first grade in Electromechanical/Renewable Energy as per GTD Classification. International Contractors shall demonstrate at least equivalent qualifications by experience for the scope described above. The lead Partner must demonstrate experience in design, build, and operate of WWTPs as indicated in 4.2 (b) and 6.3 (b) Experience in Key Activities.

Section I. Instructions to Applicants

A. General

- 1. Scope of 1.1 In connection with the Invitation for Pregualification indicated in Section II, Prequalification Data Sheet (PDS), the Employer¹, Application as defined in the PDS, issues this Prequalification Document ("Prequalification Document") to prospective applicants ("Applicants") interested in submitting applications, ("Applications") for prequalification to bid for the Works described in Section VII, Scope of Works. In case the Works are to be bid as individual contracts (i.e., the slice and package procedure), these are listed in the PDS. The International Competitive Bidding ("ICB") number corresponding to this prequalification is also provided in the PDS.
- 2. Source of Funds
 2.1 The Employer as indicated in the PDS has applied for or received financing (hereinafter called "funds") from KfW Development Bank (hereinafter called "KfW") towards the cost of the project named in the PDS. The Employer intends to apply the funds to eligible payments under the contract(s) resulting from the bidding for which this prequalification is conducted.
- **3. Corrupt and**3.1 KfW requires compliance with its policy in regard to corruptFraudulentand fraudulent practices as set forth in Section VI.
 - Practices 3.2 In further pursuance of this policy, Applicants shall permit and shall cause its agents to provide information and permit KfW or an agent appointed by KfW to inspect on site all accounts, records and other documents relating to the submission of the Application, bid submission (in case prequalified), and contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors or agents appointed by KfW.
- 4. Eligible 4.1 An Applicant may be a firm that is a private entity, or a combination of such entities in the form of a joint venture ("JV") Applicants under an existing JV Agreement or with the intent to enter into such an agreement supported by Declarations of Association. In the case of a JV, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the Contract in accordance with the Contract terms. The Applicant shall nominate an authorized representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of the Applicant and any and all its members, if the Applicant is a JV, during the prequalification process, bidding (in the event the Applicant submits a bid) and during contract execution (in the event the Applicant is awarded the Contract). Unless specified in the PDS, maximum number of members in a JV is two.

¹ Instead of Employer, the term Project Executing Agency or Contracting Authority might be used interchangeably.

- 4.2 A firm may apply for prequalification both individually, and as part of a JV, or as a subcontractor. If prequalified, it will not be permitted to bid for the same contract both as an individual firm and as a part of the joint venture. However, a firm may participate as a subcontractor in more than one bid, but only in that capacity. Bids submitted in violation of this procedure will be rejected.
- 4.3 KfW's eligibility criteria for prequalification are described in Section V Eligibility Criteria.
- 4.4 Applicants shall not have a conflict of interest. Any Applicant found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. An Applicant may be considered to have a conflict of interest for the purpose of this prequalification process, if the Applicant:
 - a. Directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by or is under common control with another Applicant; or
 - b. Receives or has received any direct or indirect subsidy from another Applicant; or
 - c. Has the same legal representative as another Applicant; or
 - d. Has a relationship with another Applicant, directly or through common third parties, that puts it in a position to influence the application of another Applicant, or influence the decisions of the Employer regarding this prequalification process; or
 - e. Any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the works that are the subject of the prequalification; or
 - Any of its affiliates has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the Employer as Engineer for the Contract implementation; or
 - g. Has a close business or family relationship with a professional staff of the Employer (or of the project implementing agency, or of a recipient of a part of the loan) who: (i) are directly or indirectly involved in the preparation of the prequalification documents or specifications of the contract, and/or the prequalification evaluation process; or (ii) would be involved in the implementation or supervision of such contract unless the conflict stemming from such relationship has been resolved in a manner acceptable to KfW throughout the procurement process and execution of the contract.
- 4.5 An Applicant shall not be under suspension from bidding by the Employer as the result of the execution of a Bid–Securing Declaration.

- 4.6 An Applicant shall provide such evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Employer, as the Employer shall reasonably request.
- 5. Eligible Materials, Equipment, and Services
 5.1 The materials, equipment, and services to be supplied under the Contract and financed by KfW may have their origin in any country subject to the restrictions specified in Section V Eligibility criteria, and all expenditures under the Contract will not contravene such restrictions.

 Documents
 6.1 These Prequalification Documents consist of parts 1 and 2 which comprise all the sections indicated below, and which should be read in conjunction with any Addendum issued in accordance with ITA 8.

- 6.2 Unless obtained directly from the Employer, the Employer accepts no responsibility for the completeness of the Prequalification Documents, responses to requests for clarification, or Addenda in accordance with ITA 8. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the Employer shall prevail.
- 6.3 The Applicant is expected to examine all instructions, forms, and terms in the Prequalification Documents and to furnish with its application all information or documentation as is required by the Prequalification Documents.

- 7. Clarification of 7.1 A prospective Applicant requiring any clarification of the Pregualification Documents shall contact the Employer in Pregualification writing at the Employer's address indicated in the PDS. The **Documents** Employer will respond in writing to any request for clarification provided that such request is received no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the deadline for submission of the applications. The Employer shall forward a copy of its response to all prospective Applicants who have obtained the Prequalification Documents directly from the Employer, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. If so indicated in the PDS, the Employer shall also promptly publish its response at the web page identified in the PDS. Should the Employer deem it necessary to amend the Prequalification Documents as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under ITA 8 and in accordance with the provisions of ITA 17.2.
- 8. Amendment of Prequalification Documents
 8.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Applications, the Employer may amend the Prequalification Documents by issuing an Addendum.
 - 8.2 Any Addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Documents and shall be communicated in writing to all prospective Applicants who have obtained the Prequalification Documents from the Employer. The Employer shall promptly publish the Addendum at the Employer's web page identified in the **PDS**.
 - 8.3 To give prospective Applicants reasonable time to take an Addendum into account in preparing their Applications, the Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications in accordance with ITA 17.2.

C. Preparation of Applications

- 9. Cost of Applications
 9.1 The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Application. The Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the prequalification process.
- 10. Language of Application
 10.1 The Application as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the prequalification exchanged by the Applicant and the Employer, shall be written in the language specified in the PDS. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Application may be in another language, provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language specified in the PDS, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Application, the translation shall govern.

- Power of Attorney shall be provided by the Lead Member nominated in the JV Agreement or in the Declarations of Association, submitted in accordance with ITA 4.1. If the representative of the Applicant is the owner, member or director of the Applicant or the Applicant's Lead Member, if so nominated in accordance with ITA 4.1, a Power of Attorney shall not be necessary.
- c. Presentation of the Applicant (maximum 10 pages, no brochures). If the Applicant is a single entity, the Presentation shall describe the Applicant's type of entity, ownership structure and organization chart, as well as its main business areas as they apply to the project. If the Applicant is a JV, the Presentation shall provide this information about each JV member as well as a description of the intended form of collaboration of the members within the JV. Where the Applicant's qualifications to carry out the assignment have been acquired as a result of a merger or acquisition, the presentation must include a detailed business history of the Applicant.
- d. Statements and Declarations: False information provided in the following Statements and Declarations by the Applicant or in the case of an JV by any of the JV members shall lead to the exclusion of the Applicant from the tender process:
 - i If the Applicant is an existing JV, the Applicant shall submit a proof of the existing Association Agreement, indicating the Lead Member. If the Applicant is a JV, which the members intend to form for the purpose of executing the contract, each member of the association shall submit a Declaration of Association, indicating the Lead Member, in the format provided in Annex Section IV, Application Forms.
 - ii Declaration of Undertaking in the format provided in Section IV, Application Forms. If the Applicant is a JV, only one Declaration of

Undertaking must be submitted, i.e. the representative of the JV can sign on behalf of the JV subject to a power of attorney.

iii Financial Capacity Statement in the format provided in Section IV, Application Forms and supported by the Applicant's Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss

Statements. If the Applicant is a JV, separate statements, including the supporting Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss Statements, shall be provided by each member of the JV. All Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss Statements shall be certified by a reputable auditor.

List of project references in the format provided in Section IV, Application Forms. Unless otherwise stated in the **PDS** the references shall be limited to a maximum of 5 projects carried out during the 10 years preceding the publication of this prequalification document. The Employer reserves the right to contact the clients indicated in the references to ascertain the information provided by the Applicant.

List of Available Expertise and Human Resource Capacity in the format provided in Section IV, Application Forms.

- e. All Application forms and required attachments, provided in Section IV, Application Forms. If the Applicant is a single entity, in accordance with ITA 4.1, it should not include form ELI 1.2 in its Application.
- f. Any other documents required in the **PDS**.
- 11.2 The Applicant shall furnish information on commissions and gratuities, if any, paid or to be paid to agents or any other party relating to this Application.

- 12. Application12.1The Applicant shall complete an Application Submission Form
as provided in Section IV, Application Forms. This Form must
be completed without any alteration to its format.
- 13. Documents
 Establishing the Eligibility of the Applicant
 13.1 To establish its eligibility in accordance with ITA 4, the Applicant shall complete and sign the Declaration of Undertaking as provided in Section IV, Application Forms without any alteration to its format and furnish supporting documentation as specified in Forms ELI 1.1, ELI 1.2(a) and ELI 1.2(b).
- 14. Documents14.1To establish its qualifications to perform the contract(s) in
accordance with Section III, Qualification and Evaluation, the
Applicant14.1To establish its qualifications to perform the contract(s) in

Applicant shall provide the information requested in the
corresponding Forms included in Section IV, Application
Forms.
- 15. Signing of the Application and Number of Copies
 15.1 The Applicant shall prepare one original of the documents comprising the Application as described in ITA 11 and clearly mark it "ORIGINAL". The original of the Application shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Applicant. In case the Applicant is a JV, the Application shall be signed by an authorized representative of the JV, designated in accordance with ITA 4.1, on behalf of the JV.
 - 15.2 The Applicant shall submit copies of the signed original Application, in the number specified in the **PDS**, and clearly mark them "COPY". In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.

D. Submission of Applications

- 16. Sealing and
Identification of
Applications16.1The Applicant shall enclose the original and the copies of the
Application in a sealed envelope that shall:
a. bear the name and address of the Applicant;
 - b. be addressed to the Employer, in accordance with ITA 17.1; and
 - c. bear the specific identification of this prequalification process indicated in the **PDS** 1.1.
 - 16.2 The Employer will accept no responsibility for not processing any envelope that was not identified as required in ITA 16.1 above.

- 17. Deadline for
Submission of
Applications17.1Applicants may either submit their Applications by mail or by
hand. Applications shall be submitted in accordance with the
instructions, including the address and deadline, stipulated in
the PDS.
 - 17.2 The Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications by amending the Prequalification Documents in accordance with ITA 8, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the Applicants subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
- **18. Late**18.1Late Applications received after the deadline indicated in ITA**Applications**17.1 will be rejected.
- **19. Opening of**
Applications19.1The Employer shall open all Applications at the date, time and
place specified in the PDS. Late Applications shall be treated in
accordance with ITA 18.1.
 - 19.2 The Employer shall prepare a record of the opening of Applications, which shall include, as a minimum, the name of the Applicant and whether the Application has been received in time.

E. Procedures for Evaluation of Applications

- **20. Confidentiality** 20.1 Information relating to the Applications, their evaluation and result shall not be disclosed to Applicants, or any other persons not officially concerned with the prequalification process until the notification of prequalification results is made to all Applicants in accordance with ITA 28.
 - 20.2 From the deadline for submission of Applications to the time of notification of the results of the prequalification in accordance with ITA 28, any Applicant that wishes to contact the Employer on any matter related to the prequalification process (except as specified in 20.1 above), may do so only in writing.
- 21. Clarification of
Applications21.1To assist in the evaluation of Applications, the Employer may,
at its discretion, ask an Applicant for a clarification of its
Application, to be submitted within a stated reasonable period
of time. Any request for clarification from the Employer and all
clarifications from the Applicant shall be in writing.
 - 21.2 If an Applicant does not provide clarifications and/or documents requested by the date and time set in the Employer's request for clarification, its Application shall be evaluated based on the information and documents available at the time of evaluation of the Application.

22. Responsiveness 22.1 The Employer shall reject an Application that is not substantially responsive to the requirements of this prequalification document. An Application shall be considered as responsive if the following documents are submitted:

- 23. Domestic Bidder 23.1 A margin of preference for domestic bidders shall not apply in the bidding process resulting from this prequalification unless otherwise specified in the PDS.
- **24. Subcontractors** 24.1 Unless otherwise stated in the PDS, the Employer does not intend to execute any specific elements of the Works by subcontractors selected in advance by the Employer (nominated subcontractors).
 - 24.2 A "specialized sub-contractor" is a sub-contractor hired for specialized work as defined by the Employer in Section III 4.2 -Experience. If no specialized work is specified by the Employer as such, sub-contractors experience shall not be considered for Applications evaluation.

F. Evaluation of Applications and Prequalification of Applicants

- 25. Evaluation of Applications25.1 The Employer shall evaluate the responsive Applications using the factors, methods, criteria, and requirements defined in Section III, Qualification and Evaluation, to evaluate the qualifications of the Applicants, and no other methods, criteria, or requirements shall be used.
 - 25.2 Only the qualifications of the Applicant shall be considered. In particular, the qualifications of a parent or other affiliated company that is not party to the Applicant under a JV in accordance with ITA 4.1 shall not be considered.
 - 25.3 In case of multiple contracts, Applicants should indicate in their applications the individual contracts in which they are interested. The Employer shall prequalify each Applicant for the maximum combination of contracts for which the Applicant has thereby indicated its interest and for which the Applicant meets the appropriate aggregate requirements. The Qualification and Evaluation are mentioned in Section III.

Section V. Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility in KfW-Financed Procurement

- 1. Consulting Services, Works, Goods, Plant and Non-Consulting Services are eligible for KfW financing regardless of the country of origin of the Contractors (including Subcontractors and suppliers for the execution of the Contract), except where an international embargo or sanction by the United Nations, the European Union or the German Government applies.
- 2. Applicants/Bidders (including all members of a Joint Venture and proposed or engaged Subcontractors) shall not be awarded a KfW-financed Contract if, on the date of submission of their Application/Offer or on the intended date of Award of a Contract, they:
 - 2.1 are bankrupt or being wound up or ceasing their activities, are having their activities administered by courts, have entered into receivership, or are in any analogous situation;
 - 2.2 have been
 - (a) convicted by a final judgement or a final administrative decision or subject to financial sanctions by the United Nations, the European Union and/or the German Government for involvement in a criminal organization, money laundering, terrorist-related offences, child labour or trafficking in human beings; this criterion of exclusion is also applicable to legal Persons, whose majority of shares are held or factually controlled by natural or legal Persons which themselves are subject to such convictions or sanctions;
 - (b) convicted by a final court decision or a final administrative decision by a court, the European Union or national authorities in the Partner Country or in Germany for Sanctionable Practice during any Tender Process or the performance of a Contract or for an irregularity affecting the EU's financial interests, unless they provide supporting information together with their Declaration of Undertaking (Form available as Appendix to the Application/Offer which shows that this conviction is not relevant in the context of this Contract and that adequate compliance measures have been taken in reaction;
 - 2.3 have been subject within the past five years to a Contract termination fully settled against them for significant or persistent failure to comply with their contractual obligations during Contract performance, unless this termination was challenged and the dispute resolution is still pending or has not confirmed a full settlement against them;
 - 2.4 have not fulfilled applicable fiscal obligations regarding payments of taxes either in the country where they are constituted or the PEA's country;
 - 2.5 are subject to an exclusion decision of the World Bank or any other multilateral development bank and are listed in the respective table with debarred and cross debarred firms and individual available on the World Bank's website or any other multilateral development bank unless they provide supporting information together with their Declaration of Undertaking which shows that this exclusion is not relevant in the context of this Contract or
 - 2.6 have given misrepresentation in documentation requested by the PEA as part of the Tender Process of the relevant Contract.

3. State-owned entities may compete only if they can establish that they (i) are legally and financially autonomous, and (ii) operate under commercial law. To be eligible, a state owned entity shall establish to KfW's satisfaction, through all relevant documents, including its charter and other information KfW may request, that it: (i) is a legal entity separate from their state (ii) does not currently receive substantial subsidies or budget support; (iii) operates like any commercial enterprise, and, inter alia, is not obliged to pass on its surplus to their state, can acquire rights and liabilities, borrow funds and be liable for repayment of its debts, and can be declared bankrupt.

Section VI. KfW Policy – Sanctionable Practice – Social and Environmental Responsibility

1. Sanctionable Practice

The PEA and the Contractors (including all members of a Joint Venture and proposed or engaged Subcontractors) must observe the highest standard of ethics during the Tender Process and performance of the Contract.

By signing the Declaration of Undertaking the Contractors declare that (i) they did not and will not engage in any Sanctionable Practice likely to influence the Tender Process and the corresponding Award of Contract to the PEA's detriment, and that (ii) in case of being awarded a Contract they will not engage in any Sanctionable Practice.

Moreover, KfW requires to include in the Contracts a provision pursuant to which Contractors must permit KfW and in case of financing by the European Union also to European institutions having competence under European law to inspect the respective accounts, records and documents relating to the Tender Process and the performance of the Contract, and to have them audited by auditors appointed by KfW.

KfW reserves the right to take any action it deems appropriate to check that these ethics rules are observed and reserves, in particular, the rights to:

- (a) reject an Offer for Award of Contract if during the Tender Process the Bidder who is recommended for the Award of Contract has engaged in Sanctionable Practice, directly or by means of an agent in view of being awarded the Contract;
- (b) declare mis procurement and exercise its rights on the ground of the Funding Agreement with the PEA relating to suspension of disbursements, early repayment and termination if, at any time, the PEA, Contractors or their legal representatives or Subcontractors have engaged in Sanctionable Practice during the Tender Process or performance of the Contract without the PEA having taken appropriate action in due time satisfactory to KfW to remedy the situation, including by failing to inform KfW at the time they knew of such practices.

KfW defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

Coercive Practice	The impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any person or the property of the person with a view to influencing improperly the actions of a person.
Collusive Practice	An arrangement between two or more persons designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another person.
Corrupt Practice	The promising, offering, giving, making, insisting on, receiving, accepting or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of any illegal payment or undue advantage of any nature, to or by any person, with the intention of influencing the actions of any person or causing any person to refrain from any action.
Fraudulent Practice	Any action or omission, including misrepresentation that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a person to obtain a financial benefit or to avoid an obligation.

- **Obstructive Practice** Means (i) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing evidence material to the investigation or the making of false statements to investigators, in order to materially impede an official investigation into allegations of a Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice or Collusive Practice, or threatening, harassing or intimidating any Person to prevent them from disclosing their knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation, or (ii) any act intended to materially impede the exercise of KfW's access to contractually required information in connection with an official investigation into allegations of a Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice or Collusive Practice.
- Sanctionable Practice Any Coercive Practice, Collusive Practice, Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice or Obstructive Practice (as such terms are defined herein) which is unlawful under the Financing Agreement.

2. Social and Environmental Responsibility

Projects financed in whole or partly in the framework of Financial Cooperation have to ensure compliance with international Environmental, Social, Health and Safety (ESHS) standards (including issues of sexual exploitation and abuse and gender based violence) Contractors in KfW-financed projects shall consequently undertake in the respective Contracts to:

- (a) comply with and ensure that all their Subcontractors and major suppliers, i.e. for major supply items comply with international environmental and labour standards, consistent with applicable law and regulations in the country of implementation of the respective Contract and the fundamental conventions of the International Labour Organization²²
 - (ILO) and international environmental treaties and;
- (b) implement any environmental and social risks mitigation measures, as identified in the environmental and social impact assessment (ESIA) and further detailed in the environmental and social management plan (ESMP) as far as these measures are relevant to the Contract and implement measures for the prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse and gender-based violence.

²² In case ILO conventions have not been fully ratified or implemented in the Employer's country the Applicant/Bidder/Contractor shall, to the satisfaction of the Employer and KfW, propose and implement appropriate measures in the spirit of the said ILO conventions with respect to a) workers grievances on working conditions and terms of employment, b) child labour, c) forced labour, d) worker's organisations and e) nondiscrimination.

PART 2 – Works Requirements

Section VII. Scope of Works

1. Description of the Works

Scope of the Contract

The Contract will include the following:

Upgrade & Rehabilitation (DBO) for South Amman WWTP, with average capacity of 62,000m³/day.

1. Construction works.

The existing South Amman WWTP provides treatment through extended aeration process. This shall be converted to Conventional Activated Sludge Process. The work covered under the contract involves both the refurbishment of existing facilities as well as construction of new facilities to upgrade the level of treatment with sludge digestion and biogas generation.

Summary of the new and refurbishment works is given below:

a) New Preliminary and Primary Treatment Units:

- Influent raw wastewater screw pumping station.
- ➢ Flow measurements flume.
- Mechanical Coarse and fine screens.
- Grit and Grease Removal Tanks.
- Primary sedimentation tanks.

b) Secondary Treatment

- > New ferric chloride addition unit for phosphorus removal.
- Refurbishment of the bioreactors:
- Rearrangement of the anoxic and aerobic reactors,
- > Replacement of the mechanical aeration with fine bubble diffused aeration.
- New system for return MLSS.
- ➢ New Blower Room

c) Tertiary Treatment

> Enlargement of the chorine contact basin.

d) New Sludge Treatment and Biogas Utilization Units

- Gravity Belt Thickeners for waste sludge.
- Primary sludge pumping station.
- Primary sludge gravity thickeners.
- Sludge Blending tank.
- > Anaerobic Digesters.
- > Machinery Building for anaerobic digestion equipment.
- ➢ Gas holders.

> Belt filter presses for dewatering of digested sludge.

e) Support Facilities

- Drainage Pumping Station (The existing balancing tank and raw wastewater pumping station is utilized as drainage pumping station.
- > New Odor control system with refurbishment of some of the existing units.
- Refurbishment of the non-potable water system
- Refurbishment of the water supply system
- Refurbishment of the site irrigation system

2. Operations of the WWTP

The Contractor shall operate and maintain the WWTP for a period of 15 years after completion date. After that period, the ownership, operation and maintenance shall be transferred to Miyahuna.

The Contractor shall train WAJ staff on the required experience in operating the WWTP.

3. Design and Construction Period(s)

Construction duration including the design preparation is anticipated to be 24 months. The Retention Period shall be 12 months.

4. Other Data

Preliminary designs will be provided, and the construction works will be carried out according to FIDIC Gold Book conditions of contract "FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Design Build, and Operate 1st edition, 2008". The Works will be carried out during the operation of the existing WWTP, no disturbance to the current operation shall be allowed.

5. Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP)

The ESIA and consequently the ESMP is currently being prepared. Based on similar Projects it is anticipated that the ESMP will include requirements for the Contractor to minimize the following environmental and social impacts:

<u>Physical Environment</u>

Air Quality and Noise Level

During the construction phase noise and dust are likely to occur by land preparation activities and by the movement of heavy machinery. This impact is considered temporary and usually of low significance.

Construction and Demolition Waste

Construction will require a lot of materials including cement and/or ready-mix concrete, steel, geomembranes, pumps, sand and gravel, etc. While most of the materials will be used on site, construction and demolition waste (e.g., defective materials, packaging waste) will require proper handling on-site and appropriate disposal off-site.

Flood Hazards

Flash floods may occur at the site due to sudden and intense rainfall. Such floods could develop inside the WWTP or travel through the WWTP and may cause soil erosion and/or damage to some of the WWTP structures.

Soil Pollution

During construction phase, soil pollution may result due to the accidental spillage of oil /fuel from construction machinery.

Fluid Waste

Absence of appropriate fluid wastes management system especially for hazardous waste including fuels and solvents will increase the possibility of occurrence of negative impacts on the surrounding environment and to public health.

<u>Odors</u>

Under normal operating conditions the impacts of odor will be minimal. However; significant impacts might occur due to inefficient operation of the TP. The impacts of generated odor can affect residential areas near the treatment plants.

<u>Terrestrial Ecology</u>

The project locations do not overlap or close to any biological important areas, i.e. protected areas, important bids areas, parks, etc. However, below impacts may occur:

Disturbance for Wildlife

This impact may occur during construction activities for the exiting wildlife, mainly birds at South Amman WWTP, the area is surrounded by natural terrains and farmlands, where the wildlife species may occur.

Wood Collection

This impact is also may occur during the construction activities by the workers who may collect wood by cutting natural bushes or trees to make fire.

Illegal Hunting and Animal Capture

This impact may occur during construction and operation activities by workers, it most likely if happen to be at the area surrounding the WWTP area.

<u>Socio-economic</u>

Disturbance to traffic

The predicted impact of disturbance to traffic is expected to be as a result of machinery movements in project sites.

Health and safety of workers and the general public

Construction activities will entail all the usual occupational risks associated with construction operations. Demolition and excavation operations will expose the workers to the risk of injury from falling debris. Other potential hazards are associated with the use of heavy construction machinery on the site.

Risk to the public health is anticipated as a result of increased traffic movements in the project area.

Land Acquisition

The potential land acquisition issues are not likely to be faced by the construction of the WWTP since there is sufficient space available within the existing boundaries of the WWTPs plants.

The following are the specialized studies done by Employer, and shall be annexed to the Tender Documents :

- Hydrology study
- Survey Study
- Geotechnical investigation
